VICTORIAN LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREA (LGA) DATA TABLES

RESULTS BASED ON RESIDENTIAL LGA OF AGGRIEVED FAMILY MEMBER / VICTIM AT TIME PRESENTING TO THE HOSPITAL EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT (VEMD), APPLICATION FINALISED (COURT DATA) OR FAMILY VIOLENCE INCIDENT REPORT (POLICE DATA)

The Appendix to this report contains information on family violence incidents reported in public hospital emergency departments, to police and finalised intervention order applications in the Magistrates' and Children's courts of Victoria, by the residential Victorian Local Government Area (LGA) for aggrieved family members / victims.

Each year the VFVD project receives many requests for LGA level data and therefore produced this Appendix to provide information for the seven year period 1999-2006.

The data tables included in this Appendix provide a summary of key variables for each LGA (residential LGA of aggrieved family member / victim). The tables are provided primarily to assist LGAs with information about family violence within their local area for planning purposes.

The data tables present overall summary counts and percentages for the LGAs, and are presented in alphabetical order for each of the LGAs. Many LGAs have small numbers of aggrieved family members / incidents presenting in any given year. Caution must be used when analysing data for areas with small populations as a small shift of only a few cases across different categories can have a large impact on the percentage rates in any given year.

Overview of the Victorian Public Hospital Emergency Dataset (VEMD) contained in this Appendix

VEMD data is introduced for the first time in this current report.¹ The importance of inclusion of this data was highlighted in a report by the Monash University Accident Research Centre (Sherrard et al 1994) which identified that two per cent of all injuries to women presenting in

emergency departments were considered human intended and inflicted by domestic partners. In addition, a small control study sample conducted with Victorian Injury Surveillance Systems (VISS) ² data identified that 20 per cent of cases included in the VISS had a history of suspected injuries not detected prior to this study (Sherrard et al 1994, p. 76). This same report also estimated that 70 per cent of partner inflicted injuries are *undetected* in the emergency department (1994, p. 74).

The importance of detecting family violence cases through the emergency department is important for linking women otherwise not seeking assistance into intervention systems. Stark and Flintcraft (1991) highlight the importance in detecting these cases to enable early linkages into health, social service and justice systems to prevent escalation into more severe and longer term violence.

In 2003-2004 the Victorian public hospital system introduced a category of “human intent injury” which identified injuries caused by a family member as either “child maltreatment by parent / guardian” or “maltreatment by domestic partner”.

For the year 2004-2005 the total number of admissions in emergency departments across the Victorian public hospital system was 1,158,474. Of these, 15,806 were classified as *human intent* injuries with 693 (four per cent) deemed to be family violence related.

As the human intent data field identifying injuries associated with family violence is relatively new, analysis has only commenced with data from the most recent two years 2004-2005 and 2005-2006.
