Please note:

- Applicants must have a minimum security rating (C1 or C2) prior to release onto Home Detention.
- The Home Detention eligibility date is calculated as having served two thirds of the sentence and being eligible for parole or straight release within 6 months or less.
- Applications will be accepted at any stage of a sentence, however, applications may be deemed ineligible on the basis that there is 'insufficient time' to adequately participate in the program (under 8 weeks on Home Detention)
