Meeting overview

Opening

The meeting was opened by the Chair who thanked members for attending.

Community feedback and community issues

Agency staff

- The Facility aims to convert all long term agency staff to permanent positions over the next 12 months.
- Two information sessions were held regarding jobs at the centre. Both sessions were very well attended. There is a lot of community interest in working at the Facility.

Local issues

- Re-vegetation at entry to the facility needs to be established and maintained, particularly at the long-distance truck drivers' truck stop site.
- Need to ensure environmental offsets are maintained in the area.

Project update

- Chair delivered the project update and addressed any questions the group had about the build.
- Next meeting the Chair will bring a floor plan to discuss the 'pro-social' operating philosophy underpinning the new build.
- As part of the new build, the meeting Chair (and Facility MD) is currently designing the emergency response with relevant agencies. Chair will communicate this response to the Malmsbury Mail, with the CFA. CFA group member to draft response.
- Local Victoria Police patrol the facility.

Community engagement
